

Pre-Requisite	 Achieved Diaper Dolphins exit skills Child at least 30 months old 3rd Year of life
Description	Fun and energetic class filled with activities that motivate children to be water safe, every child 4 & under, regardless of ability or prowess should CHOOSE to call a parent before entering a body of water
Objectives	 Enhance child's body balance and limb coordination, safer than any other sport Control and move in a low gravity (multi-dimension) environment Develop breath control Be careful in order to gain self-esteem and independence Learning to follow instructions
Time Commitment to Safety	Recommended annually, either/or, - ~32 weekly 40 min group lessons: 4 seasons annually during school year / 8 weeks each approximately - ~35 sessions of 20 min of 1 on 1 instruction - Attend summer camp at least 4 weeks should include aquatic education
Exit Skills	 Breathing & nose protection Fetching objects from the bottom 4' to 5' with assistance Breath holding 6"-10" Submerge mouth blowing trumpet "ppppp" for 3" or submerge head making a balloon face for 6"seconds Safety & flotation Float Independently for up to 10 seconds Glide on Front alone Glide on back with assistance Body movement & balance Simultaneous and symmetric movements of extremities: Dolphin and Frog like movements Summersault backwards with assistance Roll front to back to take a breath. Roll back to front and swim to wall 2 yards March on the bottom of the pool, with assistance, in water above head Navigation Jump in from the side of pool, return to wall or cross corner of the pool 6-10 feet without assistance Enter and Exit Water Independently Can swim a distance of 15 feet
